

Tenth Congress of the republic of Texas

At the First Session

*Begun and held at the town Washington-on-the-Brazos on Monday, the twelfth day of December,
Two Thousand Five*

An Act

To establish understanding and harmony in communications between various officers serving in the branches of government and their various entities and franchises.

Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives in Congress assembled;

Sec. 1. Known as H.R. 10-03-18-004 and Senate No. 2006-02-005

Sec. 2. The ***official*** language for the republic of Texas is ***American English***. Only when translations are necessary by the judiciary for making understandable for communications for determining a cause or; when in matters with other states when with heads of states translations are necessary for understanding the communications between nations such other language(s) to suit the timely requirements may be used. All documents written in any foreign language must be accurately written in American English, certified by the translator as “true and complete under the pain and penalty of perjury”. The translator is subject to criminal charges or treason as the case may be for inaccurate or incomplete translations.

Sec. 3. All operations and entities under charter from the republic of Texas must keep and maintain a set of their records in American English, but are not prevented hereby from using another language to make records of the same American English records for their own cause. All sets of records must be certified identical in meaning, intent, accuracy, and completeness under the pain and penalty of perjury as stated in *Sec. 1*, immediately above.

Sec. 4. Certain ones within the republic of Texas defense forces and national security departments may from time to time be expected for brief periods, but only when necessary to exercise or implement their lawful duties provided American English is retained as the *official* language and all communications written or not are subject to the penalties stated in *Sec. 1*, herein.

Sec. 5. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage: All laws and statutes conflicting are hereby repealed.
