County Tales

Galveston Island was part of the original Austin Colony that the Republic of Texas sold in 1836 to Michel B. Menard.

Menard, a native of Canada, purchased a "league and labor" of land for \$50,000 from the Austin Colony to establish the City of Galveston.

Menard and his associates bought the site from the Republic of Texas. The city was incorporated in 1839.

Galveston's harbor became an active port with ships from all over the world importing their goods and was officially designated a port of entry by the Congress of the Republic of Texas.
