The Independence Of Texas Declared On March 2nd 1836

AND

The Texas Republic Restoration Declared On December 12th, 2005 Happened For **EXACTLY** The Same Reasons.

The Texas Declaration of Independence was produced, literally, overnight by a committee of 5 delegates. Its urgency was paramount, because while it was being prepared, the Alamo in San Antonio was under siege by Santa Anna's army of Mexico.

Excerpts from the Texas Declaration of Independence.....

".....When a government has ceased to protect the lives, liberty and property of the people, from whom its legitimate powers are derived, and for the advancement of whose happiness it was instituted, and so far from being a guarantee for the enjoyment of those inestimable and inalienable rights, becomes an instrument in the hands of evil rulers for their oppression".

".....When, in consequence of such acts of malfeasance and abdication on the part of the government, anarchy prevails, and civil society is dissolved into its original elements. In such a crisis, the first law of nature, the right of self-preservation, the inherent and inalienable rights of the people to appeal to first principles, and take their political affairs into their own hands in extreme cases, enjoins it as a right towards themselves, and a sacred obligation to their posterity, to abolish such government, and create another in its stead, calculated to rescue them from impending dangers, and to secure their future welfare and happiness".

".....These, and other grievances, were patiently borne by the people of Texas, until they reached that point at which forbearance ceases to be a virtue. We then took up arms in defence of the national constitution. We appealed to our Mexican brethren for assistance.

Our appeal has been made in vain. Though months have elapsed, no sympathetic response has yet been heard from the Interior. We are, therefore, forced to the melancholy conclusion, that the Mexican people have acquiesced in the destruction of their liberty, and the substitution therefore of a military government; that they are unfit to be free, and incapable of self government".

"...The necessity of self-preservation, therefore, now decrees our eternal political separation".

...."We, therefore, the delegates with plenary powers of the people of Texas, in solemn convention assembled, appealing to a candid world for the necessities of our condition, do hereby resolve and declare, that our political connection with the Mexican nation has forever ended, and that the people of Texas do now constitute a free, Sovereign, and independent republic, and are fully invested with all the rights and attributes which properly belong to independent nations; and, conscious of the rectitude of our intentions, we fearlessly and confidently commit the issue to the decision of the Supreme arbiter of the destinies of nations".

The urgency of the Restoration of the Texas republic also is paramount because its status is also under siege, not by gunfire but by political control, power plays, ploys, deceptions. and arrogance....while the perpetrators laugh all the way to the bank! It was not overnight however because.....**something strange happened.** Many Texas people took exception to the brave souls who took on the challenge that would benefit all people

of Texas in human privacy, dignity, and freedom, yet pay reverence to a system that entices, lie, dangle 'carrots', while, hell-bent on destroying privacy, dignity and freedom.

That is one of the reasons that it is understandable if many of these flyers are thrown on the ground...never read.... Another reason these flyers will go unread is because no one wants to admit they've been 'going along' letting others control so much of their day to day living to the point of 'allowing' any and every conniving, scheming enslavement tactic, subtle at first but now out and out blatant. But, there is no benefit in chiding one's self for ignoring messages of this nature. Go forward...learn all you can to protect self, family and posterity, today!

Keep in mind what today means.

Things are changing.... Which do you choose....living under the current conditions or accepting the changes that keep the wolves in sheep's clothing at abeyance, the unlawful creditors and thieves away from your doors, allow free enterprise, the joy to work at whatever you love, keep more of your earnings than you now give to government? Consider this fact before you answer! There was merely a "**Resolution**" by the U.S. Congress to create the "Treaty of Annexation,," but... **a Treaty of Annexation never took place** (confirmed by the U.S. National Archives). This is the basis for the restoration of the republic of Texas. Proclamation of the Transitional Plans of the 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas Government of God and We the People;

Notice: This is not an official document.

It is being distributed to better give all Texians a better overall picture of the 10th Congresses major priorities. Anyone may add to this but please send all changes back to me or one of the Congressmen or the President or the Vice president.

Preamble:

I. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall immediately institute the flag for the Texian American People that shall fly over their Nation's lands of Texas. Whereas intern The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall immediately authorize the People's government and their President to officially serve notice to all nations on this Earth.

II. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall immediately institute and bring forward the 1836 Constitution in tact for the organic republic of Texas and by joint resolution declare all declared Texian inhabitants men, women and children of our Creator for all destinies equal to each one and all under our Creator.

III. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall immediately, officially claim all lands under God set in place by several organic International Treaties for the Texian American inhabitants and shall officially serve all Nations on this Earth.

IV. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall immediately institute a constitutional medium of exchange, of intrinsic value, for the purpose of supporting a national economy.

V. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall immediately determine the existence of any treaties or agreements between the Republic of Texas and other nations, to establish and reaffirm peaceful international relations, recognition, commerce and trade.

VI. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall create and take applications for legislative chartering of corporate businesses on the lands of Texas. The Congress shall set fees for said charters. The Congress shall take actions to adjudicate, restrict or prohibit non-chartered corporations from acting in commerce on the lands of Texas and shall not allow any entity to do so, or same shall be adjudicated as

liable under the Common Law of the Republic of Texas.

VII. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall, when expedient, attach all assets on behalf of the People of the Republic of Texas, to be preserved for same, including any and all trust accounts, controlled, held by, or accruing to THE STATE OF TEXAS, the State of Texas and any derivatives of same, whether located within or without the borders of the Republic of Texas, for the use of the treasury of the Republic for the operations of the Nation.

VIII. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall immediately declare and officially Notice and Demand all non-chartered Corporate agencies acting for or as THE STATE OF TEXAS, the UNITED STATES, US, USA and or any derivatives thereof or the State of Texas and/ or the united States of America shall cease unlawful intervention and interference with the rights and properties of any declared Texian American National standing under superior International Treaty law, nor shall any statutory inferior court with color have lawful geographical venue or jurisdiction for conducting any proceeding against any Texian American National without a International Treaty with standing.

IX. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall continue the implementation of Common Law within the Republic by fostering the creation of county common law courts and by establishing common law courts in every district. No person with title of nobility shall be allowed to serve in any capacity in the judicial system and all officials shall be Texian nationals. The structure of the judicial system shall be reviewed and revised as described in detail by the Constitution in order to fully implement the practice of common law within the Republic of Texas.

X. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall act to remove foreign military forces, agencies, and policing authorities currently occupying the sovereign soil of the Republic of Texas that are operating without express written authorization.

XI. The 10th Congressional Congress for the Republic of Texas shall use any departments or Defense Forces necessary to assist, advice, and enforce the laws of the Republic of Texas in all of its endeavors to protect the rights of Texian American Nationals and to secure its borders pursuant to the law of nations as with existing treaties of the Republic of Texas.

This is how a Constitutional republic was turned into a socialist democracy.
